

**15th Appreciation Course in Legislative Drafting
(From 04.03.2013 to 15.03.2013)**

The Institute of Legislative Drafting and Research (ILDR), a Wing of the Legislative Department, Ministry of Law and Justice is organising the Fifteenth Appreciation Course in Legislative Drafting from the 4th March, 2013 to 15th March, 2013.

This Course comprises of the basic concepts of legislation including subordinate legislation and the procedure for processing of legislative proposals. The Appreciation Course is intended to fill the communication gap between the Legislative Department and the administrative Ministries/Departments, which have to conceptualise, formulate and initiate proposals for legislation as well as to prepare drafts of statutory rules, orders, etc., in respect of the Acts administered by them.

The training (theoretical as well as on-the-job) will be imparted to the officers in the ILDR Lecture Hall, Room No. 440, 'A' Wing, 4th Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi-110 001 from the 4th March, 2013 to 15th March, 2013 between 9.30 AM to 5.30PM on all working days.

Hon'ble Minister for Law and Justice will be inaugurating the said course on 4th March, 2013 at 10.30 AM.
