

SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE DRAFTING COURSE IN HINDI

The Institute of Legislative Drafting and Research (ILDR) established under the aegis of the Legislative Department is organising first legislative drafting course in Hindi from the 10th November to 10th December, 2014. This is the first Course of its kind which is being organised by ILDR since its establishment in 1989. ILDR was established as a wing of the Legislative Department with a view to increasing the availability of trained Legislative drafts persons / Counsels in the country. The Institute has been conducting various courses such as Basic Course and Appreciation course for the benefit of officers of the Central Government, State Government/Union territory Administrations.

The first legislative drafting course in Hindi is being organised for the benefit of State Government/UT officers who are involved in drafting of legislations, Rules, regulations etc., in Hindi or are likely to be associated with drafting in Hindi. The objective is to equip the Legislative draftspersons in Hindi, especially those who are working in Hindi and it is expected that these initiatives would help the law officers to acquire and enhance their skills in drafting of legislations, rules, regulations etc., in Hindi.

Organising the special legislative drafting course in Hindi coincides with the completion of 25 years of the establishment of ILDR. ILDR has recently been awarded ISO 9001:2008 certification on 2nd December, 2013 in recognition of the Quality Management System that has been put in place in the Institute. All these steps would help ILDR to expand its scope of activities in the field of training in legislative drafting.
